AUTHORIZATION TO PARTICIPATE AND CONSENT TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL TREATMENT

I hereby authorize Manteca Youth Focus, through the adult person in whose care said minor has been entrusted, to consent to any emergency x-ray examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis, or treatment and hospital care for her/him, under supervision of and as deemed advisable by a physician licensed under the Medicine Practice Act. It is understood that this authority is given in advance of the need for any diagnosis, treatment or hospital care, but is to provide authority for said adult person, pursuant to Section 25.8 of the California Civil Code. This authorization shall remain in effect throughout each meeting or regular activity during the current calendar year unless sooner revoked in writing delivered to said adult person.

Permission is hereby given to Manteca Youth Focus to utilize the non-medical information contained herein for publicity and competition purposes without any recourse from camper or family. Camper and family hereby release Manteca Youth Focus from claims of any kind or nature arising out of damages of persons or property occasioned by or in connection with any portion of the Camper's participation in any Manteca Youth Focus related events. Mini Manteca Fun Camp Official Rules and Regulations

A. Basic Requirements

ALL CAMPERS MUST:

1. Be not younger than 6 and not older than 9 as of March 10, 2012
2. Attend Mini Manteca Fun Camp scheduled for Saturday February 4, 2012 from 9-11am at the Manteca Public Library McFall Room.
3. Attend and participate in award ceremony scheduled as part of the Manteca Scholarship Competition scheduled for Friday March 9, 2012 at 6pm at Calvary Community Church in Manteca.
4. Turn in completed Entry form and fee of \$25 no later than Saturday January 28, 2012 anytime between the hours of 9am-3pm at the Manteca City Council Chambers
 - Entry fee includes free entry for camper and 1 parent/guardian into the Manteca Scholarship Competition
 - Additionally each female camper will earn a tiara and each boy camper will earn a medallion to be awarded during the previously mentioned award ceremony.
 - Camper & parent have the option to attend the Teen & Young Manteca Scholarship Competition scheduled for Saturday March 11, 2012 at 10:30am at Calvary Community Church in Manteca. Camper & 1 parent/guardian will receive free entry to this event.

B. General Requirements

1. Camper is to be attired as follows:
 - Mini Manteca Fun Camp—casual play clothes appropriate for playing games & participating in physical activity. Closed toed shoes are required.
 - Award Ceremony & Optional Activity—female campers shall be attired in party dress & dress shoes; male campers shall be attired in collared shirt, dress slacks & dress shoes. Tennis shoes and flip flops are prohibited.
2. Camper and parents agree to abide by ALL the rules and regulations set forth by Manteca Youth Focus as contained herein. Any infraction of the rules and regulations may result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of any and ALL prizes and awards.
3. Manteca Youth Focus will not be held responsible for any lost or stolen articles during any activities associated with the competition, including but not limited to rehearsals and the competition show.
4. There is no refund of entry fee for Camper dropping out of the program.
5. Camper and parent hereby authorize Manteca Youth Focus and anyone duly licensed by them to televise, photograph, broadcast, and take moving pictures of the Camper singly or in a group, and to use or reuse such materials throughout the world in perpetuity in all media.
6. Absolutely no cash prizes will be distributed.
7. Camper and parents agree that the time, method, and manner of judging shall be solely within the discretion of Manteca Youth Focus and that the decision of the judges, in ALL cases, shall be final.

C. Rules of Conduct

1. Camper is at all times to uphold the standards of conduct, which exemplify proper sportsmanship and fellowship.
2. Camper is expected at all times to behave with respect, concern, and sensitivity towards his/her fellow Campers, chaperones, and other volunteers, and whomever they might come in contact with.
3. At all times, at all activities Camper is to be in the company of a sanctioned chaperone. A sanctioned chaperone is defined as an individual; adult volunteer designated by Manteca Youth Focus and the competition director as fit to provide appropriate supervision.
4. Camper is to enter buildings and rooms only designated for activities. He/she is prohibited from leaving any building during any activity without the express permission of the directors, and then only when accompanied by a sanctioned chaperone.
